**\*\*SOMEONE WILL CALL YOU TO SCHEDULE YOUR SURGERY\*\***

- \*\* NPO (**NOTHING to eat or drink**) *after midnight the day before your surgery.* Including no tobacco, gum, mints, etc.\*
- \*\* **You MUST have someone to drive you home after the surgery. A taxi, uber or bus is not acceptable.**
- \*\* If you are taking blood thinners, which include Aspirin including baby aspirin, Ticlid, Plavix (Clopidogrel), Fish Oil, Xarelto, Pradaxa, Warfarin (Coumadin), **STOP** them 5-7 days prior to your procedure. **\*\*If You See A Cardiologist - We Will Need Cardiac Clearance From Your Heart Doctor\*\*.**
- \*\* If you are taking Ozempic, Semaglutide, Wegovy, Phentermine Or Mounjaro For Weight Loss Or Diabetes **YOU MUST STOP FOR 7-14 DAYS BEFORE YOUR SURGERY**
- \*\* If you are taking Celebrex, Ibuprofen, Naprosyn (Naprelan), Advil, Aleve, Mobic, Meloxicam, or any other type of NSAID you must **STOP** these 3-5 days prior to your procedure.
- \*\* If you are diabetic and take oral medication, please **DO NOT** take the medication the morning of your procedure. If you take insulin, please inform your doctor that prescribed them for further instructions. Please check your blood sugar the morning of your procedure and report the findings to your doctor.
- \*\* If you are taking heart medication (including vitamins for heart health), blood pressure medication, or pain medication, **you will need to talk to the hospital pre-operative** department to see if it is ok to take with a small sip of water morning of your surgery.
